Board of Supervisors, Judges and County Officials:

- If unopposed in the primary, they will not appear on the ballot again in November.
- If 2 candidates run for the position, the candidate that receives the majority vote will be the winner and it will not appear again on the November ballot.
- If 3 or more candidates run in the primary, and one of the candidates receives 50% + 1 vote, they will be elected & it will not go to ballot in November. If one candidate does not receive 50% + 1 vote, then the two candidates receiving the highest votes face a run-off in November.
