1. **PUBLIC HEARING** to consider an appeal by **enXco** of the determination of the Zoning Administrator on the method by which, not the distance, wind turbine generator setbacks should be measured from a scenic roadway, property line, public road, transmission line, railroad, dwelling, and other features or conditions. Wind turbine generator setbacks, as determined by the Zoning Administrator, are measured at the tip of the turbine blade in the 3 o'clock position when perpendicular to the setback line and calculated by measuring the full height of the wind turbine generator from ground level to the tip of the turbine blade in the 12 o'clock position.
