**SUBJECT: Prehospital Care Personnel Orientation**

**AUTHORITY:** CALIFORNIA HEALTH & SAFETY CODE, DIVISION 2.5, 1797.220.

### PURPOSE/POLICY:

Provide a uniform disbursement of EMS policies, protocols, and procedures to all Prehospital Care Personnel.

- I. **EMT's:** Orientation for EMTs will be coordinated by both the employer and the Base Hospital Liaison using the EMT Orientation form. An appointment for orientation may be required by either the Base Hospital Liaison or the employer.
- III. **Paramedics:** Paramedic orientation will be coordinated with the EMS office, the Base Hospital Liaison, and the employer. Paramedics are required to successfully complete a County Orientation Form before final Authorization (Accreditation) is issued. Inability to complete orientation within 90 days will result in termination of Solano County Authorization. An appointment for orientation with the EMS Office will take less than eight hours, and an appointment is required.

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
