**Two Arrests Made During Sex Registrants Compliance Checks**

On Wednesday September 18 the Solano County Sheriff's Office Investigations Bureau and the Solano County Probation Department, joined efforts to conduct compliance checks on residents within Solano County who are sex registrants. The compliance checks were funded by Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement (S.A.F.E.) Task Force grant overseen by the Sheriff's Office. Compliance checks on registered sex offenders who reside within Solano County are done regularly to insure the subjects are adhering to the terms of their registration and probation.

The Solano County S.A.F.E. Task Force is one of 12 participating county agencies in the Region II S.A.F.E. Task Force. The teams within the task force receive grant funding each year from the California Emergency Management Agency. The mission of the Region II S.A.F.E. Task Force is to reduce the number of non-compliant sex registrants within the region. The 12 counties involved in the task force work together to achieve this goal.

All of the sex registrants checked during the compliance checks were found to be in compliance of their terms.

At one of the residence on the 900 block of Heron Drive in Suisun deputies contacted several people. The following two subjects were arrested at that residence: BOBBIE KILLOUGH a 31 year old Fairfield resident and TAMIKA ARTIS a 40 year old Suisun resident.

KILLOUGH was arrested for possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia and ARTIS was taken into custody for an outstanding warrant for narcotics violations. Both subjects were taken into custody without incident and booked into the Solano County Jail. Killough's bail was set at \$15,000.00 and she is scheduled to appear in the Fairfield Courthouse this Friday 092013 at 1:30 p.m. Aires was later cited and released from the jail and is scheduled to appear in the Fairfield Courthouse on 10/09/13 at 8:30a.m. Although, neither Killough nor Artis are registered sex offenders, these types of sweeps often result in deputies contacting individuals who are either wanted or committing other crimes.
