**INFORMATION RELEASE**  
**PURSUIT ENDS WITH SUSPECTS ARREST**

**09/24/13**

Early this morning at just after 1 a.m. Solano County Sheriff Deputies Ryan McEachern and Daniel Stoddard observed a silver 1984 Toyota Camry in the area of Grennan Drive and Webb Street in Vallejo. As the deputies followed the vehicle they ran the license plate and found the Camry had been reported stolen to B.A.R.T. Police Department in Concord on 09/15/2013.

The Deputies waited for Vallejo Police Department to arrive in the area then attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver of the Camry, who was later identified as suspect **Raykheem Guthery a 21 year old Vallejo resident**, accelerated to speeds of approximately 50 miles per hour on residential streets and violated several traffic laws. The Sheriff Deputies and Vallejo Police pursued Guthery for a short distance until Guthery exited the vehicle while it was still in gear and rolling. The Camry continued rolling and did not come to a stop until it hit and damaged the fence of a resident on Grennan Court.

A perimeter was immediately established utilizing additional personnel from the Sheriff's Office and Vallejo Police Department and a search of the area ensued. Guthery was found a short time later hiding in a garbage can in front of a residence in the 2700 block of Georgia Street which was approximately ¼ mile from where Guthery exited and ran from the vehicle. Guthery was taken into custody without incident.

Deputies ran a warrant checks on Guthery and found that he was currently wanted for two outstanding warrants for parole violations. Guthery was arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail on the following list of felony charges: motor vehicle theft, evading police, receiving stolen property, and the two parole violation warrants. Additionally, Guthery was booked on the following misdemeanor charges: hit and run causing property damage and resisting arrest.

Guthery first court appearance is scheduled for Thursday 09/26/13 at 1:30 p.m. in the Fairfield Courthouse. Guthery is currently being held in the Solano County Jail with a no bail status due to his parole violation warrants.
