

Community and Stakeholder Outreach Meetings

To Discuss Options for Regulating Medical Marijuana Operations in Unincorporated Solano County

Solano County is considering regulatory options for medical marijuana related operations in the unincorporated areas of the county. As part of this decision-making process, Solano County is embarking on a public outreach effort to discuss and gather input on a range of options and approaches to addressing medical marijuana activities in unincorporated Solano County.

The current ban on medical marijuana dispensaries in unincorporated areas expires in July 2014. Given the complexity of State and Federal laws pertaining to marijuana and medical marijuana, and recent Federal directives and court cases that affect how medical marijuana can be addressed at the local level, the County is evaluating its options for addressing the potential placement of medical marijuana dispensaries and related activities prior to the end of the current medical marijuana dispensary ban.
