Election Results - Reporting 2.0

The 2013 Consolidated Districts Election was successfully executed, and new technology was piloted by the Registrar's office to improve the administration of elections. We have created a new partnership with Integra Business Services. Integra provides a seamless web based results reporting tool that is compatible with our election tabulation software. This new display of web results as you can see below allows us to provide a more robust report on election night and through the canvass period. In addition to the results being downloaded directly from our website, candidates and interested organizations can view election results by summary, by a specific race, precinct or even by a candidate. This flexibility will allow users watching the results to hone in on a specific area of interest, and not have to scroll through all of the races when updates are posted. We successfully implemented this reporting tool in 2013, and plan to post our historical election data in the same format (back to 2006).

Faster Election Equipment Return!

For those of you that have participated in the election process, you'll know that one of the challenges for our office is ensuring the return of all the necessary ballots, equipment, supplies and forms on election night. This process has grown to include multiple bags - five per precinct! In the 2013 Consolidated Districts election, we

deployed Radio Frequency Identifier tags (RFID) on our e-rosters to track when they return to our collection centers. Using RFID tags reduces staff's time opening cases, breaking seals, manually scanning barcodes, and resealing the cases after verifying equipment is properly returned.



Given that the number of bags to return has increased we want to maintain a high level of security on the returns, while expediting the check in process. Having the ability to track the return of supplies by walking past the radio antenna and posting the information directly to our asset tracking software will help us to achieve these goals. We will expand this project to track all of our equipment being returned by RFID tag in upcoming elections.

Gearing up for 2014 Elections

The table to the right shows the districts that are participating in the 2014 November Election. Some of these offices may be decided in the June Primary, but as currently scheduled, there are over 50 different districts participating in the November Election in 2014. The jurisdictions highlighted in blue are the new districts participating who switched from odd-year elections to the even-year cycle.

These complicated ballots will require additional effort by our staff throughout the upcoming year in organizing the candidate nomination and qualification process; coordinating with state and local agencies for ballot designations; multiple eyes coordinating the layout and proofing of statements, ballots, sample ballots, and notices; additional training for pollworkers; coordination of additional polling places; and many more tasks to ensure a successful, accurate, transparent, secure election is conducted.
