I hereby request from Solano County Environmental Health an exemption from Vallejo Garbage Service on one of the following basis:

- 1. ___ That every residential unit on the property is vacant or temporarily unoccupied for a period in excess of two weeks;
2. ___ That I am a senior citizen over 62 years of age on a low to moderate fixed income who will share one 32 gallon (maximum) container with an immediately adjacent neighbor. (Signed Agreement attached)

- 3. ___ That I am the occupant of a single-family dwelling who recycles all, or virtually all, garbage and refuse produced by the occupants of the premises pursuant to recycling procedures approved by Resource Management. (Ordinance 380 N.C.(2d) 3, 1977; Ordinance 315 N.C.(2d) 2 (part), 1976.)

I agree to meet (by appointment) with a representative of Solano County Environmental Health who will inspect my premises, verify my current solid waste disposal practices, the occupancy status of the property and my eligibility for the exemption.

In addition, if granted the requested exemption, I agree to abide by the City of Vallejo Solid Waste Ordinance and not create a public nuisance.

An application fee of \$129 must be enclosed with this request in order for this application to be processed. Also a fee of \$66 will be assessed with each garbage service exemption renewal request. This fee is non-refundable.
